Proposed future activities involve the decommissioning and rehabilitation of two small impoundments adjacent the stream.</p> <p>The northern dam is about 1 255m² and the southern dam is approximately 743m². The landing strip is about 9 750m², but is incomplete. Construction of the landing strip is ceased, with approximately 30m at the watercourse end and 100m at the top end of the landing strip remaining unconstructed (these areas need to be tarred).</p> <p>The activities commenced between April and October 2013.</p> <p>In 2015, gabions were constructed along the banks of the unnamed stream. The construction of the gabions was undertaken subsequent to heavy rains and flooding in 2013. The gabions are to prevent further erosion and mitigate any future flooding risk. The physical size of the gabions is approximately 413m².</p> <p>Proposed amendment: The proposed amendment will include the construction of eight gabion weirs and berms with a development footprint of more than 100m² within the unnamed stream. The existing box culvert bridge structure will be stabilised by placing reno mattresses upstream and downstream of the structure and the construction of gabion walls that will tie into the edge of the wing walls at the bridge.</p>

Stream bank erosion control measures proposed for the farm include the planting of indigenous vegetation in conjunction with gabion structures (already constructed) to stabilise the eroded banks. Part of the proposed maintenance activities to be undertaken include the following, among others:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> placing of geo-fabric lining or graded stone filter between the gabion basket and the stream bed to prevent fines from being washed out from behind the gabions. The protection of gabions through additional toe protection measures such as a reno-mattress or stone fill at the toe. <p>Proposed amendment: The proposed amendment entails changes to the approved stabilisation and rehabilitation measures within the unnamed stream. These changes include cleaning and deepening the streambed, constructing eight gabion weirs and berms, building a siltation basin, and widening the stream by 6m. The existing northern box culvert bridge will be stabilised by placing reno mattresses upstream and downstream of the structure, along with the construction of gabion walls that tie into the edge of the wing walls at the bridge. To increase hydraulic surface roughness, indigenous wetland plants will be introduced within the stream channel.</p> <p>The approved maintenance measures have been amended in the MMP. The amended MMP is attached to the 2016 MMP and included in the amendment report.</p>
